

## VEHICLE SAFETY CHECK

Once every one to two weeks, the following safety check should be carried out:

### Under The Bonnet Check

All items that require regular checking are marked with yellow tops or handles.

1. Check **radiator** when cold. Remove radiator cap and check the colour of the coolant. The level should be at the very top.
2. **Coolant** overflow bottle should be filled up to the FULL mark only.
3. **Oil** level should be between the indicators as marked on the dip stick.
4. **Brake fluid** level should be up to the mark on the holding tank.
5. Windscreen **washer bottle** should be full of tap water.

### External Check

1. Check for inflation on all the **tyres**. Check tyres and the spare for tread all the way across the tyre.
2. **Lights** operation and condition. Make sure there are no damaged lenses or lights out.
3. Check the **seat belt** condition and their operation, especially when you are carrying passengers.
4. Check the windscreen **wiper rubbers** and operation of the washer nozzles on the spray.
5. General **cleanliness** of vehicle, inside and out.

### Servicing

Service of vehicle should be carried out by the manufactures recommendations. Usually every 5,000 to 10,000 km or every 6 months, whichever comes first.
